## From the SD's Study

Dear Members and Friends of the Greater Dayton Emmaus Community:

I am now reading a book that I purchased at the book table on one of the recent Emmaus Walks entitled The Sacred Romance. The main idea of the book is that there are two kinds of experiences in life that thrust themselves on us. One is the experience of Romance - Romance meaning all of those ways that God attempts to speak to us - in nature, in other people, in the direct intervention of the Holy Spirit, etc. The other is what the authors term the experience of Arrows - those Arrows that pierce our hearts and cause us to move away from the Romance - or the message of the Arrows?

On our own Emmaus Walk, we had the two voices speak to our spirit - the message of the Romance said: "I am God - I am wooing you - you are special - come to Me - let Me embrace you." The other voice - the Message of the Arrows- said: "You can never move beyond your pain - your pain of sin, meaninglessness, and life experiences. Give in to the negative message."

This is why we need to stay connected - to our Share Group, to our church, to our friends - to all those who will help us "re-connect" with the Message of the Romance.
